- 2 3 4 Policy 5.K: Intellectual Property that is Educational Material 5 5.K.1 IntroductionRights of Ownership to Intellectual Property that is Educational Material 6 7 Creating and disseminating knowledge are fundamental missions for the University of 8 Colorado. The broad creative environment of the University fosters the development of 9 intellectual property. In this policy, the University of Colorado reaffirms its commitment to 10 the principles of academic freedom (see Regent Law 5, Part B – Academic Freedom), and also reaffirms its commitment to encouraging the development of intellectual 11 12 property. This policy functions in accord with other University of Colorado policies and 13 federal and state statutes and regulations. 14 15 The focus of this policy is specifically on intellectual property that is Educational Material, 16 the nature of which has evolved as instructional delivery, educational accountability, and 17 needs/expectations of students have changed. A separate policy on intellectual property 18 applies to ownership of discoveries and patents, including software, and nothing in this 19 policy shall affect ownership of such intellectual property. See Regent Policy 5.J -20 Intellectual Property on Discoveries and Patents for Their Protection and 21 Commercialization, and the corresponding APS 1013. Finally, this policy recognizes 22 intellectual property associated with Scholarly and Creative Works and the ownership 23 thereof. Ownership of intellectual property is held by its authors, creators, researchers or 24 innovators, except under the special circumstances as described in this policy and in the 25 policy on discoveries, patents and software. Ownership and copyrights in scholarly and 26 artistic works-- including, but not limited to, textbooks, electronic media, syllabi, tests, 27 assignments, monographs, papers, models, musical compositions, works of art, 28 unpublished manuscripts, and the like--will be the sole and exclusive property of the 29 creator or author. Educational materials created for classroom and learning programs, 30 including electronic media, such as syllabi, assignments, and tests, shall remain the 31 property of the author, creator, researcher and innovator. Exceptions are: (1) those 32 cases in which the production of such materials is a part of a sponsored program, (2) 33 those cases in which the materials are created under the specifically assigned duties of 34 employees other than faculty, or (3) those cases in which substantial university 35 resources were used in creating educational materials. 36 37 38 5.K.2 Rights of Ownership to Intellectual Property that is Educational Material 39 Substantial Use of Resources

#### 144 5.K.6 Written Agreements

If substantial resources are used, or their use is anticipated, at any point in the creation of
 educational materials, then a negotiated written agreement must be signed by the creator(s)
 and a designated representative from the campus where the educational materials shall be
 created.

# **5.K.7** Reporting Requirements

Any person formally affiliated with the University shall be obligated to report in a timely manner any efforts to create Eeducational Mematerials that might fall under the authority of this Regent policy and other University policies, such as the conflict of interest policy, the conflict of commitment policy, and the policy on the use of the University name.
