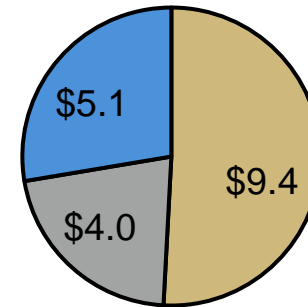

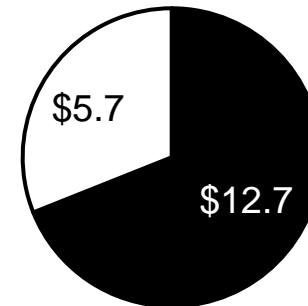

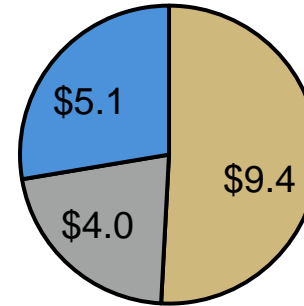
Total = \$18.4 million

- HEERF II Student Share awarded in Spring 2021



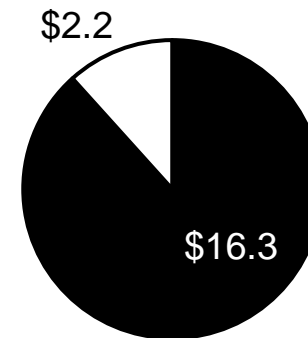

■ FY 2020-21 ■ FY 2021-22

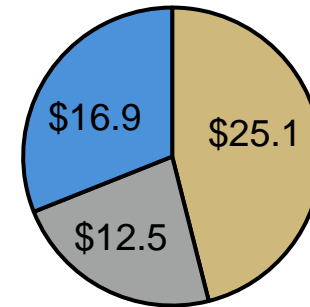

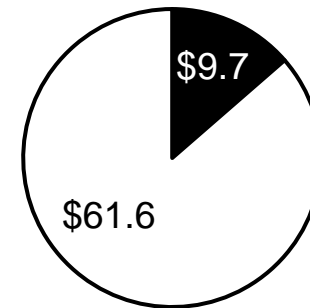
