

CU Boulder – Enrollment Overview

- Fall 2024 preliminary enrollment is currently projected to be 3.5% over fall 2023, and 3.0% over the June budget
- Preliminary first-year cohort is projected to be 7,430 students, a decrease of 1.5% over fall 2023, and an increase of 4.4% over the June budget
- New transfer enrollment is projected to be at 1,605 students, an increase of 86 students (5.4%) over fall 2023
- Continuing undergraduate enrollment is projected to be at 22,925 students, an increase of 1,283 students (5.6%) over fall 2023
- For second year, most of the incoming undergraduate enrollment increase is from resident students enrolling at a higher rate than anticipated vs June budget
- Graduate enrollment is projected to be at 6,498 students, an increase of 52 students (0.8%) over fall 2023
- Additional revenue from enrollment increases will run through the campus budget model, following APS 4058






CU Boulder – Undergraduate Enrollment With Historical Degree Completions

UCCS – Enrollment Overview

- Overall fall 2024 preliminary enrollment projected to be flat compared to fall 2023 enrollment and on target with June budget
- Preliminary fall 2024 enrollment projections over fall 2023:
 - New undergraduate transfer students +14.5% (106 students)
 - Graduate student enrollment +4.4% (81 students)
 - Non-resident graduate enrollment +2.5%
 - Continuing graduate enrollment +6.4%





CU Denver – Enrollment Overview

- Preliminary fall enrollment is -1.7% below fall 2023, and +1.8% over June budget
 - Preliminary fall enrollment indicates a smaller incoming freshman class than prior year
 - New transfer students increased over fall 2023 due to strengthened recruitment and yield efforts
- Continuing undergraduate students anticipated to be flat year over year, better than budgeted due to significant efforts to reenroll eligible students
- New graduate students increased, driven by strength in Colorado residents
- Continuing graduate enrollment decreased as anticipated due to cohort effects from strong growth in new graduate students enrolled during the pandemic
- New graduate international students increased significantly over fall 2023 as credential evaluations were brought back in-house





CU Anschutz – Enrollment Overview

- Preliminary fall enrollment is projected to be 1.1% over fall 2023 and 0.3% over June budget
- Higher enrollment projected in PharmD Program compared to June estimates
 - June estimates projected 11.4% decline
 - Preliminary fall 2024 estimates projecting 5.9% decline
 - +\$855,000 increase to budget
- Lower enrollment in the College of Nursing
 - -17 student (-1.4%) decrease from fall 2023 census
 - \circ -\$430,000 decrease to budget
- Higher enrollment in School of Medicine MD Program
 - +23 student increase from fall 2023 census
 - +\$444,000 increase to budget
