- RE: Regent Law Article 1, Part B: Mission of the University of Colorado

Regent Law Article 1, Part B provides, "The University of Colorado is a public research university with multiple campuses serving Colorado, the nation, and the world through leadership in high-quality education and professional training, public service, advancing research and knowledge, and state-of-the-art health care. Each campus has a distinct role and mission as provided by Colorado law."

This regent law was adopted in 2010 and was last reviewed by the Board of Regents in 2018. In May 2024, the Regent Governance Committee approved a five-year schedule for the continuing formal review of all regent laws and policies. Pursuant to this schedule, this regent law is due for review. Staff does not recommend any changes.

Under Regent Policy 2.N, Regent Law Article 1, Part B will be discussed by the Governance Committee on March 25, 2025; will be noticed publicly to the full board on April 10-11, 2025; and will be further discussed by the Governance Committee at its May 15, 2025, meeting. Accordingly, any changes to Regent Law Article 1, Part B could be considered at the June 5, 2025, Board of Regents meeting. Because this is a regent law, any changes would require a two-thirds vote by the Board of Regents.
