For Faculty, University Staff, Classified Staff and Retirees to designate beneficiaries on CU insurance plan(s) who do not have employee portal access. If you have access to your employee portal, <u>please see the instructions at the bottom of this form.</u>

Beneficiary information:

- If you do not designate a beneficiary for your insurance plans, benefits will be paid according to the provisions of the group policy.
- Beneficiary designations of your most current form revoke all prior designations.
- Primary beneficiary receives the benefit in the event of your death.
- Contingent beneficiary receives the benefit only if your primary beneficiary(ies) are deceased.
- If you name more than one primary or contingent beneficiary, indicate the percentage assigned to each and make sure the total in each category equals 100%. Use whole numbers only, no decimals.
- The employee is the beneficiary on all dependent insurance plans.

How to Add, Change or Remove Beneficiary(ies) in the Employee Portal

Follow these steps to designate your beneficiaries in your employee portal:

- 1. Login into your employee portal (external link).
- 2. Select the Benefits and Wellness tile (or select from the CU Resources dropdown menu).
- 3. Select the Benefits Summary tile.
- 4. On the summary **select** the plan(s) you want to edit beneficiaries for (Employee Basic Life, Employee Optional Life and/or Employee Voluntary AD&D).
- 5. Select Add Beneficiary to add a new beneficiary.
- 6. Select **Update Beneficiary Designation** to allocate percentages. The total percentage between beneficiaries must be a total of 100 percent. To remove a beneficiary, change the percentage to 0 percent.

Note: If you no longer wish to have this individual visible in your employee portal, submit the <u>Dependent/Beneficiary Removal form</u> (external PDF).

7. Select **Save** - changes will be effective immediately.
