
Cost of Attendance (COA) includes:

COA shown in based on enrolled students applying for financial aid, assuming full-time enrollment (30 credit hours). Tuition & fees assumes resident undergraduate base tuition.

Housing costs typically assume students living on campus, students living off-campus independently or students living off-campus with parents.

Denver Note: Beginning in FY 2022, financial aid adjusted the COA calculations to be better aligned with CCHE guidelines. The COA more accurately captures the difference in costs for students with On-Campus Housing vs. Off-Campus Living with Parents, which lowered the average Cost of Attendance in financial aid data.










