









Freshman Retention Rates - Residency














Freshman Retention Rates - Pell Recipients



First Generation Status based on self-reported student information, whether or not parent(s) earned a bachelors degree.








Freshman Retention Rate - State Comparison

- The Anschutz Medical Campus does not enroll first-time freshmen.










Freshman Retention Rate - Peer Comparison
