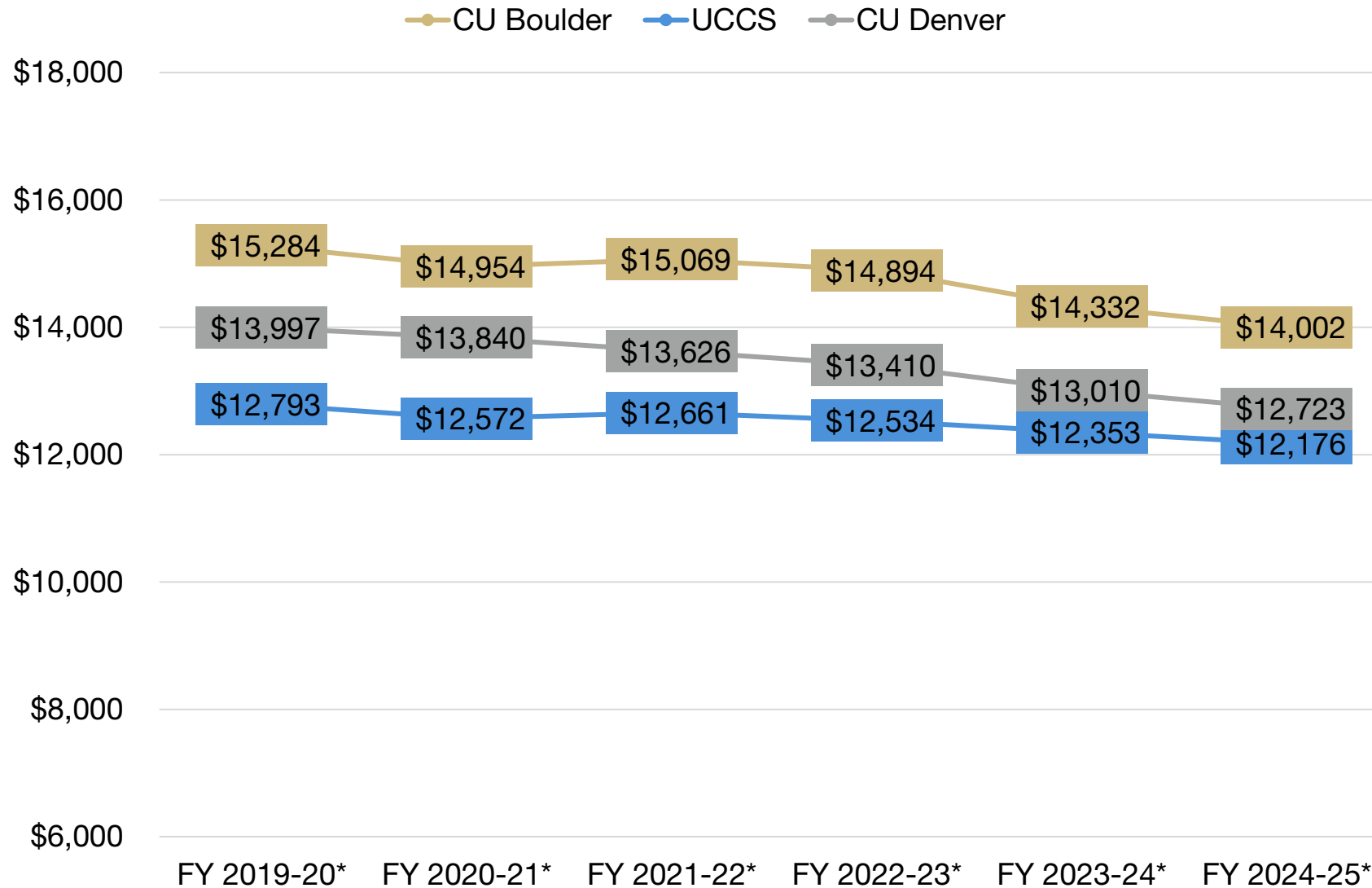

Adjusted Resident Undergraduate Base Rates (includes mandatory fees)



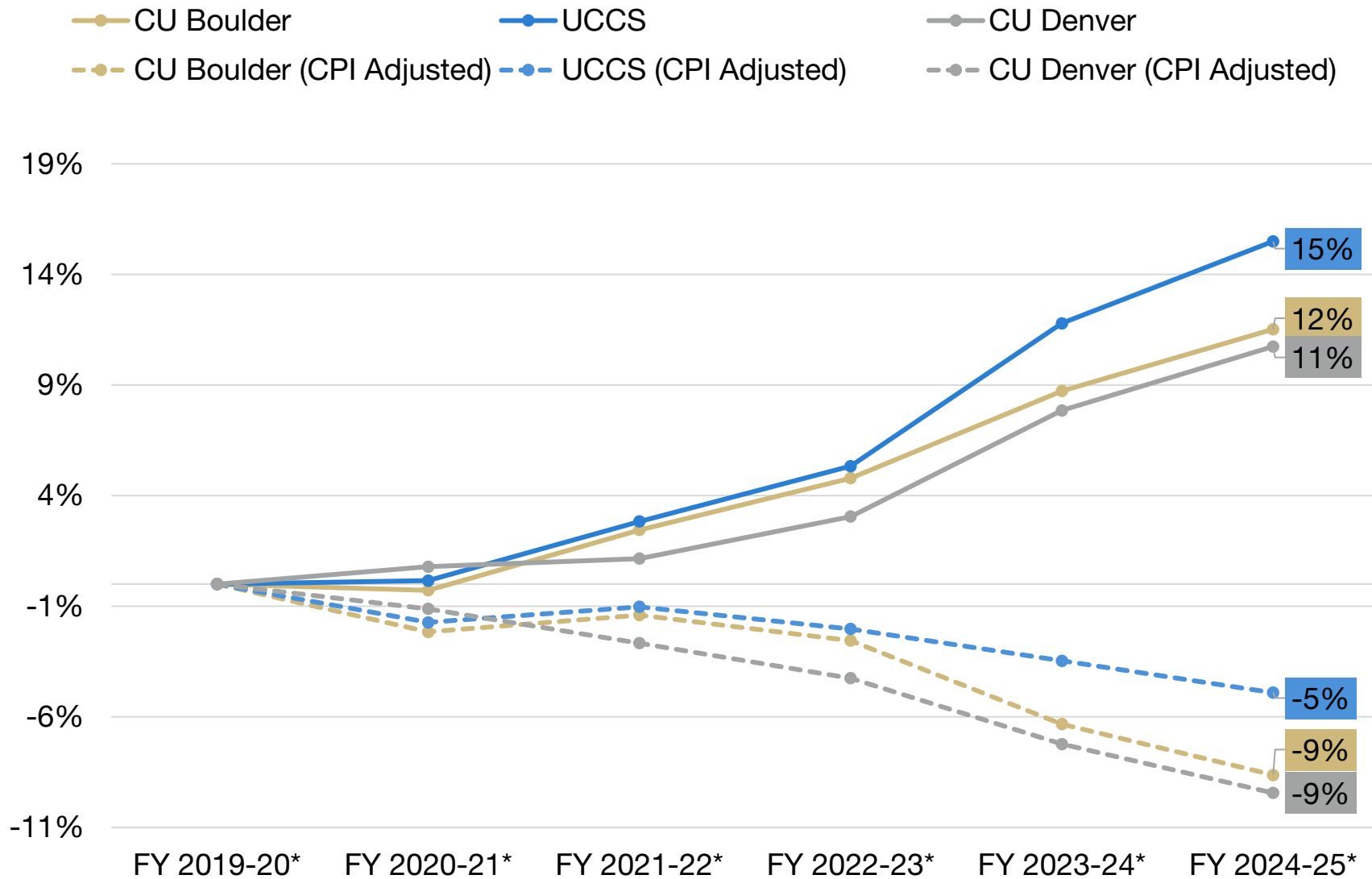
