



2014 challenges




- FileMaker Instant Web Publishing (IWP) had growing compatibility issues with some browsers
- Eventually phased out and replaced with Web Direct, which didn't translate existing form processing
- New pricing structure for Web Direct no longer allowed unlimited connections

Efficiency & Innovation #2 (2015)



- PHP: a web scripting language that replaces IWP
- unlimited connections
- more universal browser compatibility
- integrates with html
