6 2.C.6 Intercollegiate Athletics Committee

7
8 The Intercollegiate Athletics Committee of the Regents of the University of Colorado
9 shall be a standing committee.

10
11 The committee shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

13 (A) Consider university athletics programs and related matters, including:

- 14 (1) Provide strategic direction and guidance, and make recommendations
15 to the Board of Regents when appropriate, on matters that impact the
16 entire CU system, and athletic programs.
17 (2) Review systemwide policies concerning intercollegiate athletics, and
18 review updates on conference and NCAA affiliations, e.g., conference
19 structures, NCAA-restructuring.
20 (3) Review funding methods for areas including NIL, Private Equity,
21 Endowments, University Funding, and other matters as applicable.

22 (B) Duration. The Special Committee on Athletics shall be established effective
23 upon approval of this policy by the Board of Regents and continuing for two
24 years.
