2. REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY

Regent Committees

Intercollegiate Athletics Committee

The Intercollegiate Athletics Committee of the Regents of the University of Colorado shall be a standing committee.

The committee shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- (A) Consider university athletics programs and related matters, including:
 - (1) Provide strategic direction and guidance, and make recommendations to the Board of Regents when appropriate, on matters that impact the entire CU system, and athletic programs.
 - (2) Review systemwide policies concerning intercollegiate athletics, and review updates on conference and NCAA affiliations, e.g., conference structures, NCAA-restructuring.
 - (3) Review funding methods for areas including NIL, Private Equity, Endowments, University Funding, and other matters as applicable.
- (B) <u>Duration. The Special Committee on Athletics shall be established effective upon approval of this policy by the Board of Regents and continuing for two years.</u>
