RE: Regent Policy 7.B: Standards of Conduct

Federal and state law, as well as Administrative Policy Statement 5014, govern availability of advisors to students involved in sexual misconduct proceedings. This addition to Regent Policy 7.B would require campus policies and procedures to also permit parties to other student conduct proceedings to be assisted by an advisor. This addition is based in part on the "Katie Saves" initiative, which is meant to promote mental health, protect students, and prevent suicide.

Under Regent Policy 2.N, the proposed addition to Regent Policy 7.B will be discussed by the Governance Committee on March 25, 2025; will be noticed publicly to the full board on April 10-11, 2025; and will be further discussed by the Governance Committee at its May 15, 2025, meeting. Accordingly, the proposed addition to Regent Policy 7.B could be considered at the June 5, 2025, Board of Regents meeting.
