

If you want to go back after running a drill report, click the **Previous report** button.

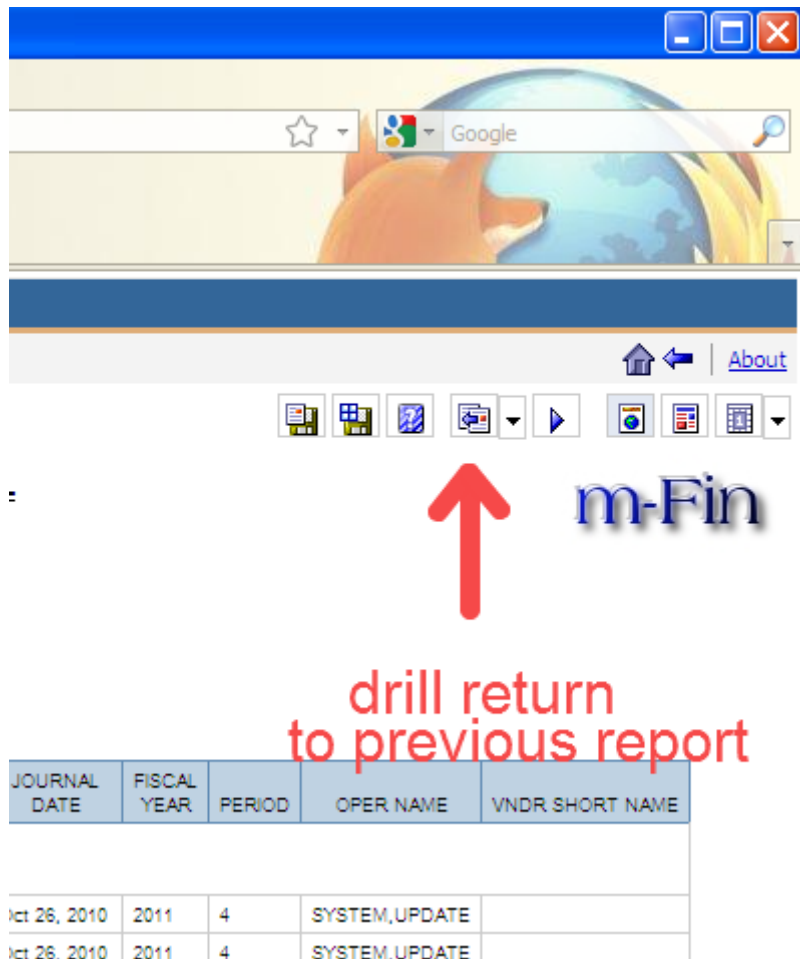
“Drills” are what we call the numbers in the reports that you can click on to run another report.

When you are done looking at the results of a drill, often you want to go back to where you were. The ordinary browser back button does not work so Cognos provides a button called **Previous report**. It only appears when you have done a drill. It takes you back.
